

#### From the Pastor

"I have set the Lord always before me; because he is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken. Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices; my flesh also dwells secure." (Psalm 16:8 ESV)

We've been looking at the principles or Keys for Spiritual Growth on Wednesday nights as God has called us to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18). I firmly believe that one of the main issues in American Christianity is that of anemic believers—those who are saved by the mercy and grace of God—and yet don't have much of a grasp on the totality of all that God is calling them to be and to do. Now, in this article I want to share with you God's Master Purpose as to why we need to grow toward spiritual maturity after having been given new life in Jesus.

In the Westminster Confession of Faith, Shorter Catechism Question #1, we're informed of the purpose for our existence when it asks: What is man's chief end? The answer is: Man's chief end is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever. Some theologians say that we actually glorify God by enjoying Him and I certainly do agree with that modification to the answer. In our Scripture above, we see this being demonstrated by King David when he speaks of setting God always before him. In other words, he's telling us that his purpose in life is to glorify God and the result is his enjoyment of God. But what does it mean to glorify God and why is this so important for us to understand? Let me share with you five reasons that I presented on one of the Wednesday night Bible Studies.

- 1. <u>God's Glory is Intrinsic to His Being.</u> The glory of God is the very essence of His being, the radiance of Himself in splendor and majesty. It's the highest expression of Himself and the manifestation of His holiness. In other words, God is in a class by Himself. He has infinite perfections, infinite greatness, and infinite worth. (Isaiah 6:1-3; Psalm 24:7-10)
- 2. God's Glory is Displayed in His Creation. The Psalmist tells us: "The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork" (Psalm 19:1 ESV). Everything that has been created, not only belongs to God, but also is made so that His glory will be revealed. (Romans 1:19,20)
- **3.** God's glory is Reserved for God Alone. God will not give His glory to anyone or anything in all of Creation. If God were to give away His glory then He would no longer be God as that which receives His glory would then be equal with Him. (Isaiah 42:8; 48:11)
- **4.** God's Glory is Expressed through His Son. Jesus, being God the Son, is the full expression of God's glory since He is also God Himself. He is the very image of the invisible God and through Him we can grasp even more the importance of God's glory. (John 1:1-4, 14; Hebrews 1:1-3a)
- **5.** God's Glory is Required of His People. And this brings us back to God's Master Purpose, that we, having been made in the image of God, though fallen into sin, are being brought back into a relationship with God that we might honor, praise, and glorify Him. (1 Corinthians 10:31; Colossians 3:17, Matthew 5:14a, 16)

Next time we'll look at God's Master Plan and how He's at work to bring us to the place where we can glorify Him. I do hope you can see the importance of our purpose, to glorify this God who has created us for His glory and His glory alone. 


#### Carol Arnold

Carol enjoys spending time with her 12 grandchildren, 10 great grandchildren, art, reading, hosting guests in her home, and traveling.


